

# **COACHES AND TRAINERS**



#### Chuck Johnson Head Coach

Coach Johnson has been the Head Football Coach at Ridgewood High School since 1984, excluding the second half of the 2019 season and the entire 2020 season when he was recovering from a serious staph infection.

This season marks his 38th year of coaching at RHS and coupled with his ten year stint as both an Assistant Football Coach and Head Coach at Bogota High School (1974-1983), totals 48 seasons coaching high school football. He has compiled 253 wins, 121 losses and 1 tie as Ridgewood's Head Coach. Adding his 35-15 record at Bogota to his Ridgewood total gives him a 289-136-1 career record.

Coach Johnson graduated from Gettysburg College in 1974 with a BA in Health and Physical Education, where he accumulated four varsity baseball letters and three varsity football letters for the Bullets. He completed his graduate work at Montclair State University. Coach recently retired from Ridgewood High School as a teacher of physical education and wellness.

Chuck is married to Sara Holmes Johnson and all three of their children are RHS graduates: Rebecca (2001), Gregory (2007) and Michael (2011).



#### Mickey McDermott Defensive Coordinator

Coach McDermott is back coaching Ridgewood football for his 2nd season. He graduated from Emerson High School in 2007 and went on to attend Charleston Southern University. He continued his degree at The Citadel where he earned his MAT

in Physical Education. Coach McDermott has 12 years of coaching experience. He is a PE teacher at Ridgewood HS..



#### AJ Torre Scout Team

Coach Torre is joining the RHS coaching staff for the first time this year after graduating Ridgewood High School in 2006 as a three sport athlete playing football, hockey and baseball all 4 years. He graduated from Neumann University in 2011 and

is currently a 1-on-1 Special Education aide at Elmwood Park school district where he also coached varsity level football and baseball.



#### Doug Aday Freshman Head Coach

Coach Aday returns for his seventh year of coaching Ridgewood Football. He graduated from Ferris High School in Texas in 2000 and attended Ramapo College of New Jersey where he played baseball and received a degree in History in 2005 and a

Masters Degree in Education in 2015. He also received an MA from Northwest Missouri State University in Special Education in 2012. He has prior coaching experience in several programs and is currently the Lead Special Education Teacher for Ridgewood High School.



#### Torre Watson Offensive & Defensive Line Coach

Coach Watson is returning for his 20th year coaching football in Ridgewood. Starting in '96, he did 18 years in the Ridgewood football program, followed by 2 years at Ramapo HS, and 4 years at Fair Lawn HS before his return in 2019. He is a '91 Graduate of

RHS, '95 Graduate of West Chester University where he was a 4-year varsity letter winner for the PSAC champions in '92 & '94. He also coaches wrestling (2000-present) and track & field (1998-present) at RHS. Coach Watson has been a PE teacher in the district since 2004 and teaches at BF middle school.



#### Ryan Maxwell Tight Ends & Outside Linebackers

Coach Maxwell is entering his fourth year of coaching the Varsity team, and has spent the previous two years coaching JV as well. He graduated from RHS in 2001 and Villanova University in 2005. Coach Maxwell is incredibly proud of his

time with the Maroons and is very excited to be coaching the same positions he played at RHS over 20 years ago!



#### Rob Gentile Offense Coordinator

Coach Gentile returns to Ridgewood this season, marking his 10th season with the Maroons and his 21st season overall coaching high school football. Coach was with the Maroons between 2004 and 2013 where he served as offensive coordinator. He

left the Maroons to pursue a Head Coach opportunity at Fair Lawn High School and then later at St. Mary's High School in Rutherford. Rob is also a physical education teacher at Fair Lawn High school.

Coach Scevola returns for his tenth year coaching football at Ridgewood High School. He coaches the running backs, linebackers and is the defensive coordinator for the freshmen team. Coach Scevola earned a Mathematics degree from the University

of Delaware in 2011 and a Masters degree from The College of New Jersey in 2014. He also teaches math at RHS and coaches the freshman baseball team.



#### Joe Crabbe Freshman Defensive Line & Wide Receivers

Coach Crabbe is entering his first year with the Ridgewood Football coaching staff. He graduated from Hasbrouck Heights High School in 2013 and attended Ramapo College where he played baseball

and received his bachelors in Education. Coach Crabbe works in our special Education program at Ridgewood High School. Coach Crabbe also has prior Varsity coaching experience in football at Hasbrouck Heights where he is currently assistant varsity basketball coach and is also the assistant varsity baseball coach at Paramus High School.


#### Nik Nicholaides MS, ATC, CSCS Certified Athletic Trainer

Ridgewood High School enjoys a reputation for being a leader in many different categories. Each year, the school receives awards for overall excellence, our athletic programs win consistent accolades, and academically, few schools can compare! But did you know that the RHS Band Program is also recognized as one of New Jersey's finest?

As charter members of the United States Scholastic Band Association (USSBA) in 1990, the RHS Marching Band has received top five divisional finishes twenty times, including USSBA Championship titles in 1992 and 1997, and state titles in 1998 and 1999. The Wind Ensemble and Concert Band have received "Superior" ratings at festivals, the jazz ensembles have received special awards at the NJ State Jazz Ensemble Festival, and our small ensembles have been honored with annual appearances at the Lincoln Center Chamber Music Society's Young Musicians Concert since 1998. Individually, members of the RHS Band Program have performed in the All-Region, All-State, All-Eastern Honor, and All-National Bands, and set a county record with 21 students selected for the 2011 All-County Band.

This year, the RHS Band Program Celebrates its 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the start of the RHS Band. The Marching Band will perform their show entitled, "The Maroon and Gold Parade," in celebration of the Centennial. This show will bring you back to 1920s jazz, a journey through the many memories of being in the band and the many students who have been apart of the tradition, and finally a little 2000s rock in celebration of the anniversary! Musical selections range from the music of Harold Arlen, traditional Southern Harmony, and My Chemical Romance to our very own RHS Fight Song, "Go Get 'Em Ridgewood."

In addition to performing at all RHS Varsity home football games, the Band will participate in six competitions during the

2022 season. These include the New Jersey State Marching Band Championships, USBands National Championships, and the Yamaha Cup (traditionally held at **MetLife STADIUM**.)

#### Class of 2013


Younghoe Koo | Georgia Southern University Eagles & Atlanta Falcons | Kicker



Younghoe's NFL career has taken off like a rocket ship. After a short stint with the San Diego Chargers in 2017, Younghoe persevered and was later signed by the Atlanta Falcons in 2019. In his debut with the Falcons, he made all four of his field goals (including a 48-yarder) and both of his extra points in an upset win over New Orleans and was named the NFC Special Teams Player of the Week.

Since then, Koo has become one of the league's most reliable boots, earning Pro Bowl honors in 2020 after converting an incredible 37 of 39 field-goal attempts, including each of his eight kicks from 50 yards or longer. He followed up that campaign making 27 or his 29 field goal attempts, including 4 of 5 from 50-plus yards, and a perfect 30 for 30 on extra points. The Atlanta Falcons rewarded their steady kicker by making him the second highest paid kicker in the NFL.
